SUMMARY

The British Aerospace Hawk Mk.100 and Mk.200 are the latest derivatives of the successful Hawk advanced trainer family.

The Hawk 100 is a 2-seat advanced trainer/light ground attack aircraft with Laser and FLIR integrated around a 1553B databus. The Hawk 200 is a light fighter with a similar integrated avionics system but equipped with an APG-66H radar. The aircraft share a high degree of commonality.

This paper describes the background to the Hawk 100/200 programme, and the flight testing which has been carried out.
